Ms. Joseph graduated from Purdue University in 2007 with a Bachelor's of Science degree in Nuclear Engineering. She began her career within Exelon Nuclear working at the Clinton Power Station in Clinton, IL as a reactor engineer.

In 2010, Ms. Joseph was the first female at Clinton Power Station to receive a Senior Reactor Operator License. Following receiving her license, Carolyn progressed through various managerial roles within the Operations Department. Carolyn has held various director roles at Clinton Power Station, including Work Management Director and Director of Organizational Performance, prior to transferring to Dresden Nuclear Power Station as the Engineering Director in 2019. In September 2020, Carolyn accepted her current role as the Director of Operations, where she is responsible for the day to day operation of both units.

During her time in the industry, Carolyn has acted as an elected member of the American Nuclear Society Executive Committee and has received an Industry Excellence Award for her outreach work with the Chernobyl Nuclear Power Plant.
